What is Laser Therapy? A surgery free, drug free, noninvasive treatment to reduce pain, reduce inflammation and increase speed of healing. Class IV deep tissue Laser Therapy uses a beam of laser light to deeply penetrate tissue without damaging it. Laser energy induces a biological response in the cells called "photo-bio-modulation", which leads to reduced pain and inflammation.

How Laser Therapy at Sheffield Works:

The laser light is delivered through a noninvasive hand piece to treat the affected area.
